Painting affords Kim Piotrowski the space to process the world and solidify her place within it. Through the manipulation of color, line, and form, Piotrowski creates dynamic compositions that become defiant celebrations. Something beautiful and inexplicable happens by way of abstraction. Passages are purposefully painted yet flow freely. They may echo nature in the manner of water, body, or landscape but aren't literal. Formal elements of color and line absorb ideas and memories to create a new visual language. The construction within the process of "making" becomes its history. In result, the paintings offer engagement and reflection of who we are together. This connection is where Piotrowski finds the greatest meaning and joy in her work.
